There are road closed signs that have been left by LCC workmen on Hillock Lane and at the top of Dungeon Lane. There appears to have been a change in the rule for using repeater sign for 30mph zones. It was agreed to ask LCC to install 30 mph repeater signs or write 30MPH on the tarmac to remind drivers that the speed limit is reduced along Higher Lane and Beacon Lane. It was also agreed that the national speed limit zones on Lees Lane, Hillock Lane and Beacon Lane, ought to be reassessed with a view to reducing the speed limit. The nature of the country roads is such that vegetation often covers signage.
